The Higher Education Funding Council for Wales (HEFCW) is a Welsh Government Sponsored Body and administers funds made available by the Welsh Government to support education, research and associated activities at ten universities in Wales and teaching by the Open University in Wales. It also provides funds for prescribed higher education courses at further education colleges. In addition, from 2012/13 HEFCW will also be responsible for taking forward the delivery of student support.

You will have knowledge of the changing higher education sector and the challenges it faces and will be able to help universities to meet the social, economic and cultural needs of Wales. We particularly wish to include members with senior experience in research intensive higher education institutions and with senior experience in private sector business especially with a finance background and/or experience of change management.

You will be required to attend seven council meetings a year and also institutional visits, workshops and committees. Most meetings will be in Cardiff, however, some may be held at other locations in Wales. Remuneration for this post will be £5,076 p.a.
