

## Content of case study synopsis

The synopsis should in a maximum of two sides of A4 covering the main points of a potential case study under the following suggested headings.

| <b>Title</b>   |
| <b>Brief description of the project</b> - including monetary value, scale, or other indicators of significance.  |
| <b>Background to supported project</b> - A brief history or description of limitations or restrictions that applied before the project was implemented. Did the project enable an expansion into new areas of research? Did the project enable the institution to secure additional resources as match funding or additional research income. Did the project support or develop existing areas of excellence. |
| <b>Partners involved in the project</b> - A note of other organisations involved or that became involved as a result of the research capital funding. Details of any new projects or additional work that the funded organisation was able to secure through any newly formed partnership.   |
| <b>Objectives of the funded project</b> - What was the project seeking to deliver, Were these objectives met or exceeded? These need to be quantified as far as possible. Has the project delivered or enabled any additional benefits that were not anticipated.  |
| <b>Links to policy</b> - Details of any links to WG, national, or international agendas or priorities.   |
| <b>Examples of research</b> - that have been enabled or supported by the capital funding provided  |
