Introduction

1. This paper provides the outcome of the strategic approach to the student experience 2013/14 to 2016/17.

Background

- 2. In March 2014 we published our <u>Strategic Approach to the Student Experience</u>: 2013/14 to 2015/16 which supported the delivery of the student experience section of HEFCW's Corporate Strategy 2013-2014 2015-16. The Corporate Strategy was subsequently extended to August 2017, which resulted in a corresponding extension to the strategic approach.
- 3. The student experience was a theme within HEFCW's Corporate Strategy 2013-15, with the objective to 'Secure excellent quality higher education and student experience, enhanced by the student voice.'
