Students eligible to be included in the calculation of PGR funding are those in 2009 RAE units of assessment (UoAs) included in the QR funding model for 2010/11. These are those units of assessment that have at least 3 FTE Category A staff or more of classified provision.

Funding was limited to 3 years for a full-time programme of study leading to a PhD and 6 for a part-time programme.

Totals may not sum due to rounding.

Postgraduate research training allocations were calculated by applying standard units of funding (for three ASC groupings) to the number of qualifying full-time equivalents (part-time counted as 0.5).
