The method for funding of postgraduate research training for 2007/08 involved funding retrospectively on the basis of enrolments in the 2005/06 academic year. Enrolments in Academic Subject Categories associated with departments rated 1 or 2 in the 2001 Research Assessment Exercise were not eligible for funding. Funding was limited to 3 years for a full-time programme of study leading to a PhD and 6 for a part-time programme.

Postgraduate research training allocations were calculated by applying standard units of funding (for three ASC groupings) to the number of qualifying enrolments.
